Pursuant to the Ohio Department of Health Order and as announced by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine on May 17, 2021, the previous Carroll County Joint Court Orders of March 25, 2021, are modified as follows:


Effective **Tuesday, May 18, 2021:**

1. All fully vaccinated employees and visitors entering the Courthouse (fully vaccinated refers to a person who is ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of a second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of a single-dose vaccine, per the CDC Public Health Recommendations for Vaccinated Persons) no longer are required to wear a mask.
2. All individuals that are not fully vaccinated shall wear facial coverings at all times until June 2, 2021, as directed by the Ohio Department of Health.
3. After June 2, 2021, any individual shall have the discretion to continue to wear a mask.
4. The hand washing and sanitation stations will continue to be available throughout the courthouse.
5. All individuals entering the Courthouse shall be subject to a non-invasive scan for elevated body temperature. Any individual, including employees, with an elevated temperature SHALL be denied access to the Courthouse.
6. Access SHALL be temporarily refused by security staff to any visibly-ill person.
7. COURTS: The presiding Judge will determine the number of participants and public access to hearings in each courtroom that is in use.
8. COURTHOUSE OFFICES: Elected official or Department Heads shall have the discretion of establishing any guidelines for their office.


